Dues Resolution

Billing Schedule and Invoices

Membership dues will be billed once each year for the full membership year and are due before January 31st. Dues invoices for the current membership year will be sent out before December 15th of the preceding year to give members adequate time for processing and payment. Invoices will be distributed via mail as well as electronically. Dues will be invoiced based on the previous year's member category and dues tier unless NOIA is otherwise notified of a change. Dues should be reviewed annually and adjusted as necessary with notice to NOIA based on the revenues or other metric for the company. Members commit to make a good faith effort to accurately report information to NOIA for purposes of dues payments.

Membership Dues

There are seventeen (17) different membership categories for purposes of dues billing and current dues rates are reflected on the NOIA dues schedule. Dues rates can be adjusted as needed with approval by the Finance Committee and Board of Directors. The current dues rate schedule will always be available on the NOIA website or via request. NOIA currently uses three different metrics to assess dues for the categories of members which are flat rate, tiered based on producing/not producing and tiered based on revenue allocated to US offshore operations.

Proration of Dues

New Members who join during the year may have their initial dues prorated on the following schedule:

- If member joins between January 1st and March 31st, 100% of annual dues will be paid
- If member joins between April 1st and June 30th, 75% of annual dues will be paid
- If member joins between July 1st and September 30th, 50% of annual dues will be paid
- If member joins between October 1st and December 31st, dues for next membership year will be paid

Delinquency and Suspension

If membership dues for the current membership year are not received by January 31st, a reminder will be sent. If dues are not received by March 31st, the member will become delinquent. A delinquency notice will be sent in April notifying Member they are delinquent, and every effort will be made to accommodate the member based on the current circumstances. If payment is not received by April 30th, a member will become suspended. A suspended member will no longer receive communications from NOIA and may not participate in NOIA events (including the Spring and Fall in-person meetings) until membership dues are paid in full. If a Member is on the Board of Directors and has not paid dues by April 30th, they will not be able to attend meetings of the Board of Directors or Executive Committee until dues are paid in full. Once dues are paid in full, the Member's suspension status will be removed.

Exceptions and Hardship

Exceptions to membership dues and delinquency status can be made on an as needed basis for purposes of recruitment and retention.

Payment Methods

The preferred methods for payment of dues are ACH, wire transfer or check. If payment of dues is made by credit card over the phone, an additional convenience fee may apply.
