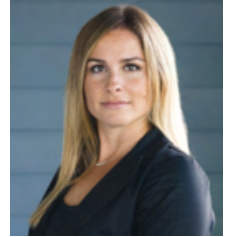

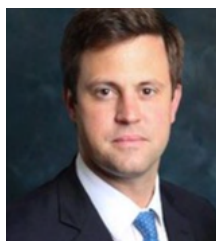

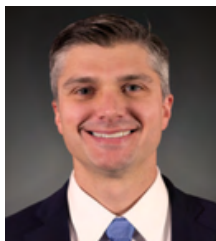

Environmental, Social, & Governance Network
