For each of the four selection criteria below, please provide a clear and concise response not to exceed two pages for a single criteria. Though supporting documentation is encouraged, the total number of pages such documentation can add to a submission is five. Any submission exceeding thirteen pages will be returned to the submitter, who, if the submission deadline has not passed, may elect to resubmit it, accordingly. A panel of judges will evaluate the responses received in order to determine which company (companies) best met the award criteria. Additional information may be requested by any judge from the submitter in order to verify or clarify any of the information contained in a response or in the supporting documents (noting that any supporting documentation submitted will be used for illustrative purposes only and will not be used to judge the submission).

Institutionalization

Describe the Culture of Safety model or system used by the organization which has enabled it to achieve its noteworthy success. Describe the investment in time, people, money, equipment (if applicable), or other resources that is directly responsible for the success. Identify the person, process or implementation technique used to immerse the organization into a culture of safety.

Achievement

We welcome entries that showcase remarkable safety achievements, surpassing routine operational practices. Describe in detail, by one or more examples, the distinctive aspects of your safety initiatives that set them apart and have prevented injury, contributing significantly to the betterment of offshore safety.

Documentation

We require comprehensive data spanning a minimum of the last five years to substantiate your organization's exceptional safety performance. The documentation submitted should encompass a concise summary adhering to acceptable interpretative standards. This may include EHS Performance and TRIR statistics, OSHA reports, near-miss data, stop-work actions, and other relevant metrics.

If your company, program, or initiative is newer than five years old, you are still eligible to participate. Please make a note on the application, indicating that five years of data collection is not yet available. In such cases, kindly include as many years of data as are presently accessible.

Industry Adaptability

The company's (or companies') culture of safety should serve as an inspiration or example for the entire industry. Please elaborate on the steps taken or elements of this model that could be adopted by other companies or prove beneficial to a broad segment of the industry.
